Wellington	near Post Office
Hawks Nest well	S-W of Coomandook
Binnies Well	W of Coonalpyn (on highway)
Cold and Wet (originally called Cold, Wet & Hungry)	S-W of Coonalpyn
Reedy Well	S-W of Culburra
Tintinara	W of Post Office, on highway
Two Wells	W-N-W of Keith
Wirreanda	S of Keith
Kongal (Well)	W of Bordertown (formerly Scott's Woolshed)
Cannawigra	Between Kongal and Bordertown
VICTORIA:	
Tolmer Rest Area	Excellent stopping point, well-equipped rest area, excellent memorial cairn with much significant historical detail
Winiam	By edge of Little Desert (enquire Nhill)
Horsham (west of)	Few miles W along highway, south side by Polkemmet turn
Glenorchy	
Troopers Creek	Roses Gap, in Grampians
Craigie	N-W of Majorca, Maryborough district
Tullaroop	Huge stone on northern side of road which crosses Tullaroop Reservoir wall
Newstead	
Chewton	No cairn, but sign post that reads 'Adelaide Road'. Short distance from Red Hill Hotel by south side of road to Castlemaine. Marks the starting point for way home for South Australian diggers and gold escorts.
